GREG GREENWAY

Friday, September 3rd - \$13 Members, \$15 Non-members

The South Shore Folk Music Club is extremely pleased to present Greg Greenway for the first concert of its 26th Season. Greg's first appearance at the Club was on May 17, 1991. He has returned many times since then bringing his audience wonderful music and a personal connection that can only come from the heart. The Boston Globe wrote, "Confessional one moment, rambunctiously disarming the next, few modern folk singers can own a Coffeehouse stage as completely as Greenway." Another reviewer said, "A profoundly rich poet and musician. Folk music is too narrow a description." Musically he draws inspiration from all over the map--gospel, rock, blues and world music. You just have to sit back and enjoy the journey. Greg has four critically acclaimed solo releases. He has appeared at Carnegie Hall in the New York Singer/Songwriter Festival, nationally syndicated *Mountain Stage*, was recently featured on the weekend edition of NPR's, *All Things Considered*, and now at the South Shore Folk Music Club.

COFFEEHOUSE – September 17 - \$5 M, \$6 NM

This special night will be a "split bill" – two great performers splitting the evening:

Twenty eight year old Demetrius has earnest, intelligent lyrics, lightning guitar work and a buttery-smooth voice to capture the hearts of his listeners. Demetrius' influences are all over the map--from alt pop, jazz, bluegrass and folk, and that has caught the attention of the Indie crowd. Fresh from Nashville, Demetrius' songwriting craft has grown surer and stronger. Catch the drive and genuine chemistry audiences feel that derives only from the fire of youth.

Local singer-songwriter Thea Hopkins is blessed with a creamy, clarion voice and a vivid, observational eye. Meditative, romantic and philosophic, Thea's music rises up with a sophisticated, melodic imagination. The songs concern the ways of the heart, but spirituality and social concerns are also constant themes. Among the most compelling is Thea's "Jesus is On the Wire" that Peter, Paul & Mary are now performing! Check out Thea Hopkins' debut tonight and then debut your talent at the open mic next!

STEVE GILLETTE and CINDY MANGSEN

If you haven't had the pleasure of attending a Steve Gillette and Cindy Mangsen concert don't miss this one. Steve and Cindy are well known as solo performers but as a duo they produce harmonies that leave their audiences spellbound. In a musical age created by the singer-songwriter, Steve Gillette has long been considered to be one of the finest and his songs have been sung by dozens of major artists including Garth Brooks, John Denver, Nanci Griffith, Waylon Jennings, Anne Murray, Tony Rice, Kenny Rogers and Linda Rondstadt. Nobody can sing a traditional ballad

like Cindy Mangsen. She has endeared herself to audiences since 1976 and has collaborated often with Anne Hills and Priscilla Herdman. She has made guest appearances on many syndicated and locally originating radio programs including *All Things Considered* (NPR) *Mountain Stage* (West Virginia Public Radio), *The Folk Heritage* (WGBH Boston) and has performed at many North American Folk Festivals. Since their marriage in April of 1989, Steve Gillette and Cindy Mangsen have been traveling, performing and recording together. COFFEEHOUSE – October 15 - \$5 M, \$6 NM

Steve Hurl plays solo acoustic blues and contemporary folk. A finger-style player, his guitar work shows some Latin & African influences. A writer of roots-based songs, his lyrics blend the personal intensity of the blues with social commentary. Steve Hurl's slide wraps 'round winning mebdies as he skillfully brings back porch country and bluesy folklore to the forefront tonight at the SSFMC.

As a performer of roots music, Marylou Ferrante plays traditional blues from the likes of Robert Johnson to Blind Boy Fuller. What attracts Marylou to country blues is the raw emotive truth expressed through songs with intricate beats and sounds. What will win you over is Marylou's sweet delta blues guitar with that sultry, passionate voice. Robert Jones says "Marylou has the soul of a blues woman" so dip into the blues with Marylou Ferrante Oct 15th! The Open Mike follows.
